PSAT 8/9 and PSAT 10 Spring 22- Student Reminders

Here are some reminders that will help you do your best on the PSAT.

Test Day General Schedule:

April 13th - 7:30am- Approximately 11:30- 12pm

• You will be released to go home after testing, provided you have a ride

Plan to arrive at school no later than <u>7:30 am</u> on each test day and report directly to your assigned room. If you arrive after testing has started, you will **not** be admitted to the testing room.

WHAT TO BRING

- Two soft-lead No. 2 pencils with good erasers (Use of pens, colored pencils, or highlighters is not permitted.)
- School ID or Acceptable photo ID
- A calculator for mathematics assessments only
 - If you use a calculator, be sure to bring a calculator that you are comfortable using, along with fresh batteries. Check the attached Prohibited Calculator list to make sure that your calculator is permitted for use on the PSAT.
- A watch (if you wish to pace yourself) Alarms must be turned off

WHAT NOT TO BRING

Do **not** bring the following items to the test room:

- Cell phone, iPad, timer, or other digital/electronic equipment
 - Use of any device to share or exchange information at any time during testing <u>or during</u> <u>the breaks</u> is a prohibited behavior. All electronic devices must be turned off and placed in your locker from the time you check in until you are dismissed after testing concludes.
- Scratch paper, notes, foreign language or other dictionary (unless used as an approved accommodation) you may do scratch work in your test booklet
- Pens, colored pencils, or highlighters
- Portable listening or recording device
- Camera or other photographic equipment
- Books, magazines, papers, etc.
- Purses, book bags, hats, or coats Can be kept in the main office if need be

TIPS TO DO YOUR BEST

- Be well rested. Get a good night's sleep the night before each test.
- Eat a healthy breakfast each morning.
- Make sure you have your picture ID, pencils, and calculator.
- Arrive on time. Students will <u>not</u> be admitted to the testing room once the test booklets have been distributed.
- Pace yourself during the test. If you find yourself spending too much time on one question, move on to the next question.
- Use breaks to eat or drink any snacks you may have brought with you. No food or drink are allowed in the testing room.
- Be positive and stay relaxed.
- Answer every question!

Acceptable Calculators

The following calculators are acceptable for use on the Math Test – Calculator. Only this test permits the use of a calculator (unless a student has an approved accommodation). This list doesn't include every calculator model. Call PSAT/NMSQT Support if you aren't sure about a calculator that's not on this list.

- All scientific calculators, which can perform complex mathematical functions but don't have a graphing feature, are acceptable as long as they don't have any prohibited features given under Unacceptable Calculators.
- All 4-function calculators are acceptable but not recommended.
- Graphing calculators included in the following table are acceptable.

Students are not allowed to use any of the following calculators, unless specifically approved by College Board as an accommodation:

- Laptops or other computers, tablets, mobile phones, smartwatches, or wearable technology
- Models that can access the internet or have wireless, Bluetooth, cellular, audio/video recording and playing, camera, or any other smartphone-type features
- Models that have a computer-style (QWERTY) keyboard, pen input, or stylus
