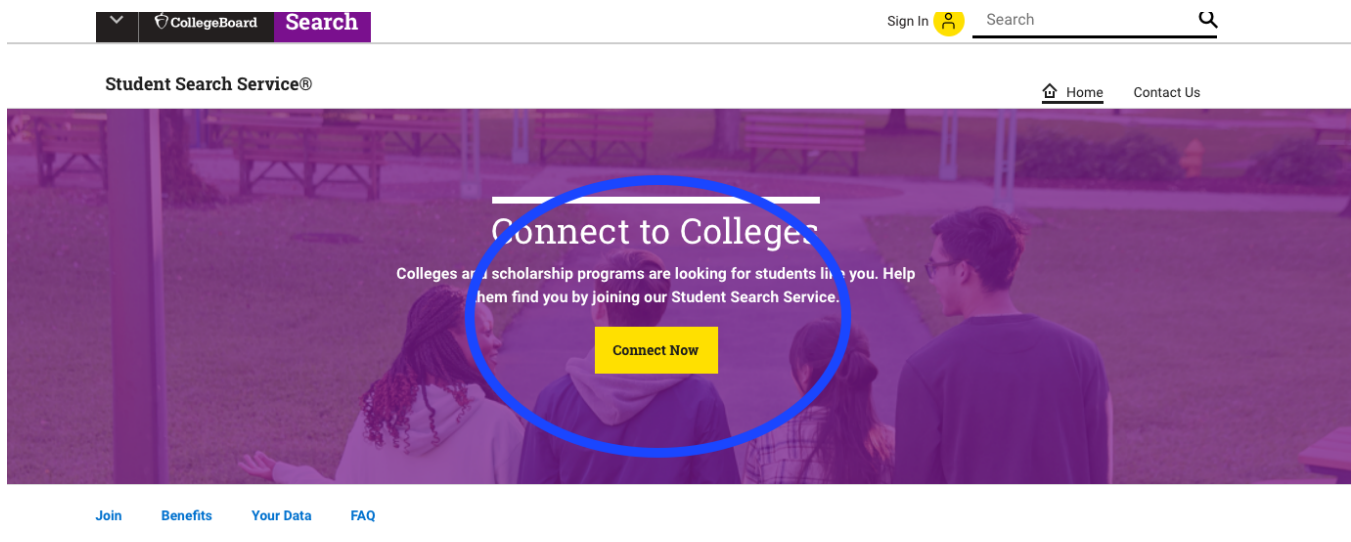


Good Afternoon,

As you are aware, Spring testing is quickly approaching. Grades 9-11 will be testing the week of April 11th, and part of these assessments includes College Board PSAT or SAT tests. To help reduce the time needed for the preadministration session in school on test day, students taking the **PSAT 10** and **SAT with Essay** can now opt into Student Search Service and complete the optional questionnaire online (<http://studentsearch.collegeboard.org>).

These fields will **NOT** be completed on test day, so students who are interested must complete them at home before testing. You will find more information on the Student Search Service along with instructions on how to complete this process here by following the prompts on the website. Click the Connect Now button at the top of the page to get started.



How Student Search Service Works for You

One click can help you learn about colleges across the country without ever leaving home.

Students will need to log into their College Board account in order to sign up for the Student Search Service. Students are directed to use their WHS email and password when creating an account. If your student has an existing account, but cannot remember their password, have them follow the prompts to retrieve it. Do not create additional accounts. That will delay and sometimes obstruct a student from receiving their scores. Only create a new account if you are positive you did not have one before. Again, please use your WHS email address and password for your accounts.

This optional process is for 10th, 11th, and those 12th grade students who will be testing only. 9th graders will not need to complete this process. Again, it is voluntary and will not prohibit your student from testing, nor will it impact their scores.
