

2018-19 Steps for application to Jackson County Early College

Link to information, pre-application, and application: www.ixncec.org

PLEASE NOTE: The application window opens November 1, 2018 and closes January 31, 2019 for early enrollment. The process must be complete and all documentation provided to be enrolled in JCEC.

- 1. Complete the pre-application which can be found under the "Application" tab and turn it in to your school counselor. Your counselor also has paper copies of the pre-application and parent waiver.
- 2. Once your counselor has received and approved the pre-application, and you have provided the supplemental materials: a signed parent waiver, letter of recommendation, and essay, you may begin the application.
- 3. Directions for the supplemental materials:
 - a) Complete a brief (250-word) essay on how Early College can benefit you.
 - b) Have a parent/guardian sign the "Parent Waiver" form which is available at www.jxncec.org or from your counselor.
 - c) Obtain a letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, employer or mentor.
 - d) Give these documents to your high school counselor.
- 4. Your counselor will include your educational development plan in your application materials.
- 5. The high school counselor will submit your completed pre-application materials to Jean Logan, the Early College Administrator.

To complete the actual application for Jackson County Early College:

- 6. Click on the Application link under the "Application" tab. This takes you to the Jackson County student account page.
- 7. If you already have applied to Jackson College, you have an account. Use your username and password to enter the system.
 - If you have not applied to Jackson College, select create account. You will select a username and password.
- 8. Once you have created an account, you will be directed to the Jackson College application page. Select "Start an Application."
- 9. Select "Start a new JCEC Application." Do not complete a traditional student application.
- 10. Follow the directions and provide the required information. Please note: the student's social security number is required for application.
